



# Art



## What skills are we learning to use?

Produce creative work, exploring their ideas and recording their experiences. Become proficient in drawing, painting, sculpture and other art, craft and design techniques.

Evaluate and analyse creative works using the language of art, craft and design.

Know about great artists, craft makers and designers, and understand the historical and cultural development of their art forms.

## What are we learning to do?

Art and Design education should engage, inspire and challenge pupils, equipping them with the knowledge and skills to experiment, invent and create their own works of art, craft and design.

## When do we learn?

Art and Design threads through all our Cornerstones Learning projects, but we also complete a termly art piece that is recorded in our "Art Learning Journey" books that move with us throughout our time at school. These activities cover a range of aspects of art such as self-portrait, photography and sculpture and will become a record of the progression of our skills in art over the years.

## What is there in class to help me?

My teacher will provide a range of experiences that will provide inspiration for me to create pieces of artwork. This may be by looking at others artists work, listening to a piece of music or thinking about my own life and experiences.

## What if I need extra support?

The teachers and teaching assistants in my class will be able to provide any extra support that may be needed.

The use of a sketch book will allow me to experiment with my ideas and practise skills.

## How does my teacher check my progress?

By talking to me about what I am creating and how I am going to achieve it. Also by looking at finished work together and thinking about how I could make improvements next time.

## How do we learn?

At KS1 pupils will be taught;

To use a range of materials creatively to design and make products. To use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination. To develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and making links to their own work.

At KS2 pupils will be taught;

To develop their techniques, including their control and their use of materials, with creativity, experimentation and an increasing awareness of different kinds of art, craft and design. Pupils will be taught; To create sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas. To improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials [for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay].

## What can you do at home to help?

Find out more about different artists using books or the internet. Discover how they created their work and who or what inspired them. Keep a sketch book and fill it with your own ideas, inspiration and experiences. It doesn't just have to be your paintings and drawings it can also be used as a scrap book to stick pictures of places, objects, materials, people or artists that inspire or interest you.
