What skills are we learning to use?

We are learning how to use a German/English dictionary and German customs during day to day life.

What are we learning to do?

In German your children will be learning to speak simple phrases, greetings and they will be able to tell you things about themselves.

Sing familiar songs in German language

What if I need extra support?

Join in our German Club, which is run every Monday lunchtime in the year 4 classroom.

When do we learn?

Classes 3-6 are being taught German on a regular, weekly basis, in the afternoon.

How does my teacher check my progress?

Progress is assessed in a very practical way by holding regular workshops where children will talk to each other and progress is recorded in the back of their exercise books.

What is there in class to help me?

All classes display the newly learnt words and phrases on a working wall, so that children can refresh their memory throughout the week.

How do we learn?

We sing songs, take learning outside the classroom and practice pronunciation in a very practical and hands on approach.

What can you do at home to help?
